Our presentation will look at the lifecycle of the a 'Through About' or 'Hamburger Roundabout', against that of a 'Pork Pie' Roundabout. From the Planning Phase, through the Construction Phase, Commissioning Phase and the handover from the Constructor into Maintenance.

We will look at the Technical Assurance Process used by National Highways, from the WSP, Amey and National Highways points of view. We will also briefly look at the upcoming changes in the DMRB and MCHW and Departures of Standard, relating to Hamburger Roundabouts. There will be a chance for questions and discussion at the end.
